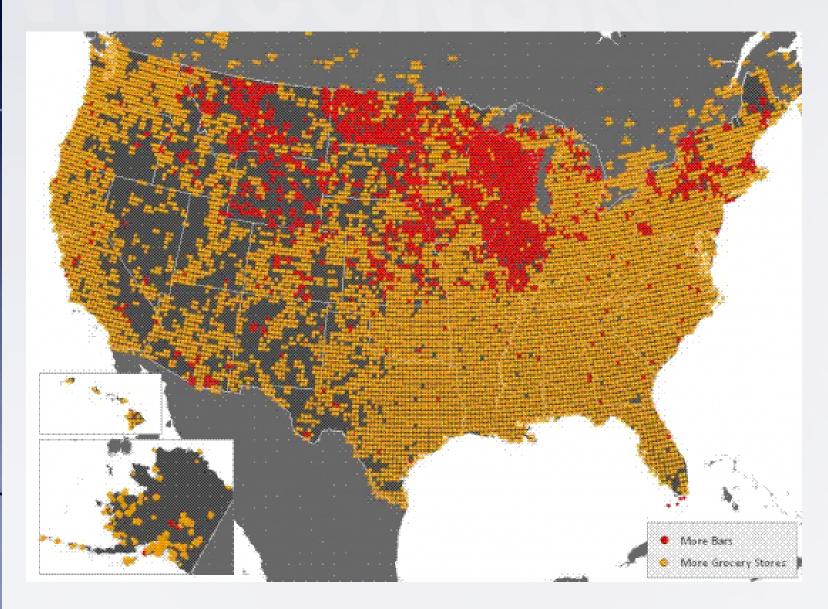

HOW BAD WAS IT? THINGS THAT NEVER HAPPENED BEFORE

- Four negative U.S. GDP quarters in a row
- Global GDP declined
- The U.S. and Japan were in recession at same time

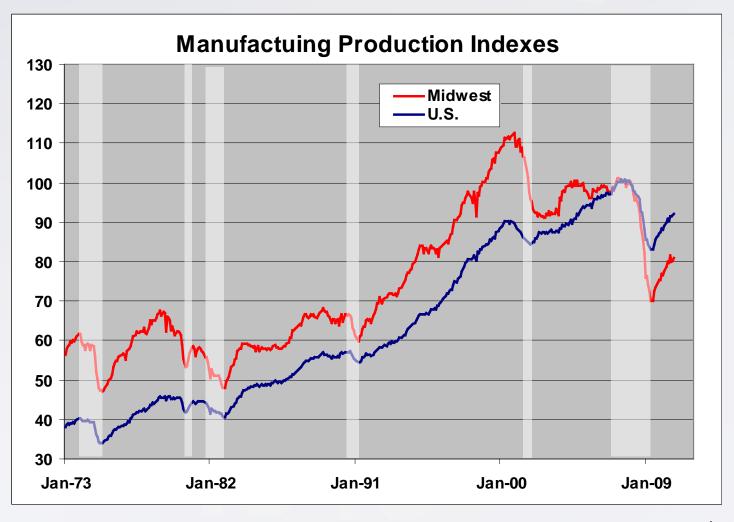
- Longest downturn since Great Depression
- Almost twice as long as post-war average recession







INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITY PLUNGED ESPECIALLY THE MIDWEST



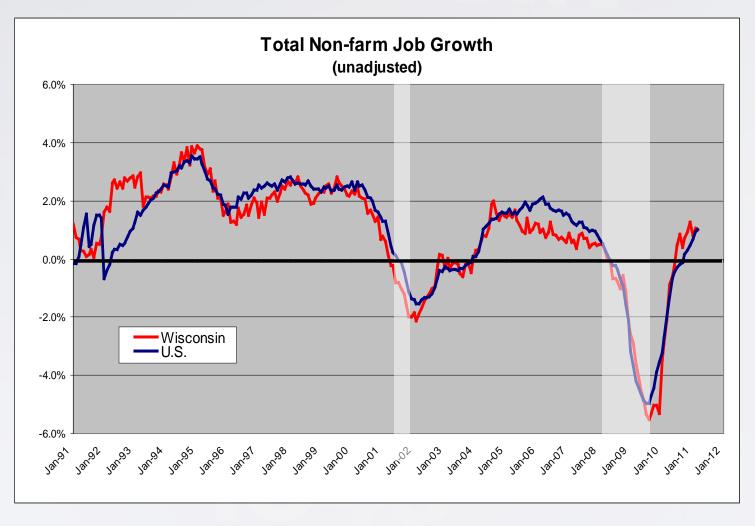

EMPLOYMENT DROPPED PRECIPITIOUSLY JOB LOSSES WORSE THAN 1981 RECESSION

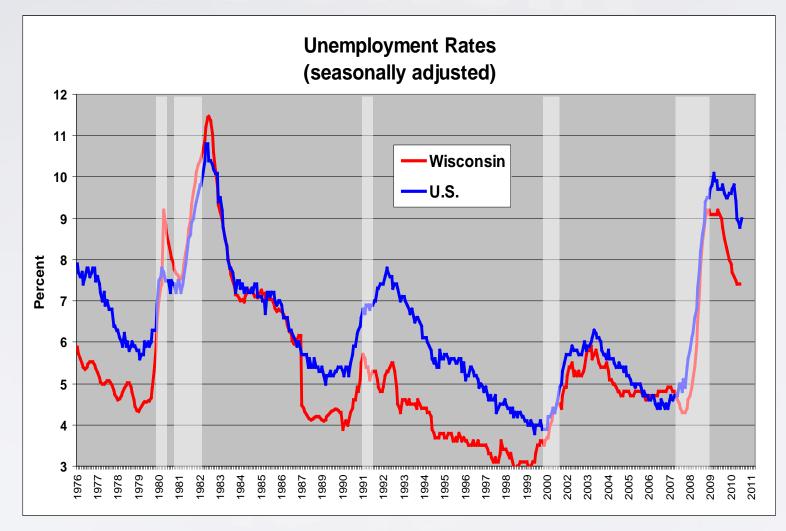








UNEMPLOYMENT CLIMBEDNOT QUITE TO LEVELS OF 1981 RECESSION

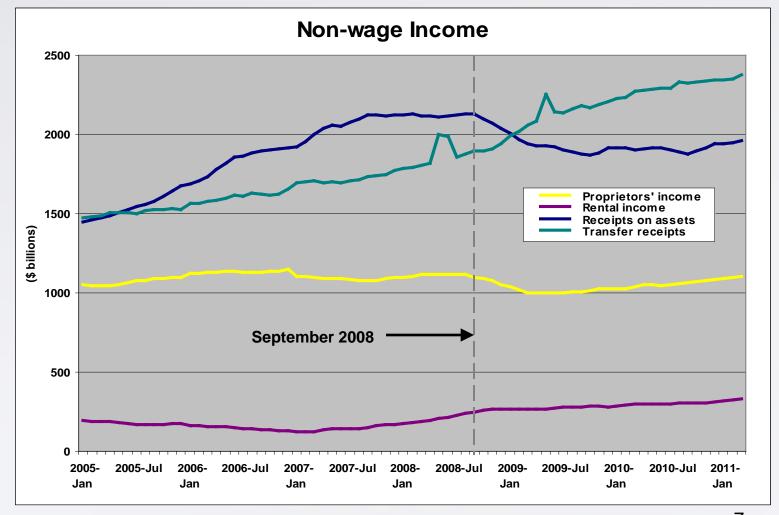








SIGN OF THE TIMES SHIFT IN SECONDARY INCOME STREAMS

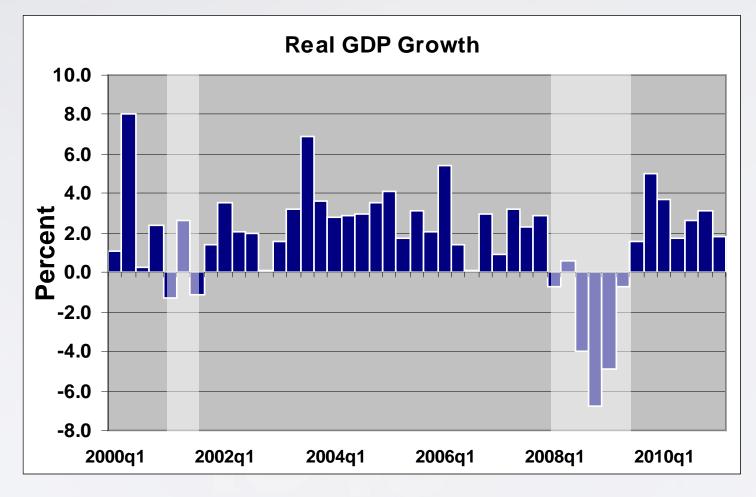

GDP; Seven positive quarters, Q1 2011 up 1.8% (prelim)







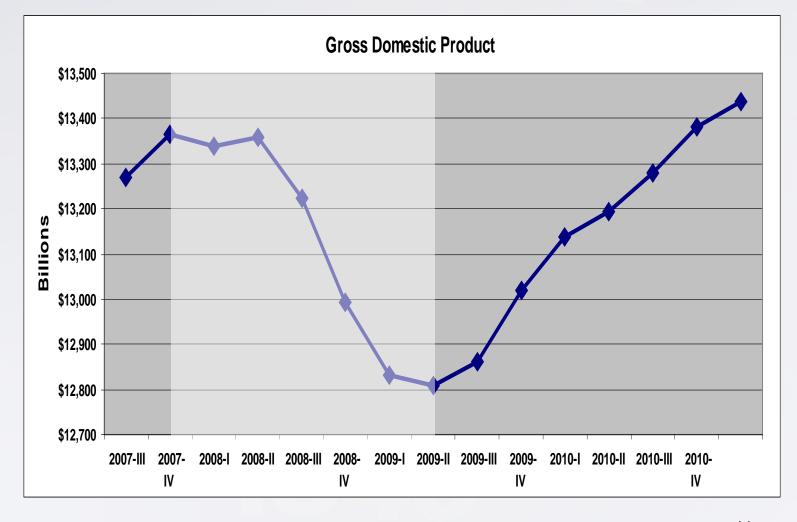

BUSINESS CYCLE SEVERESIX QUARTERS TO RECOVER

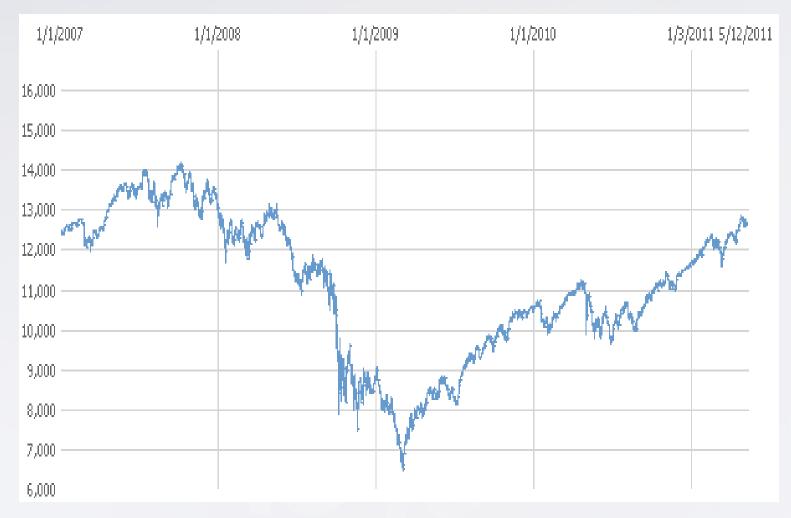

DJIA; UP 94% SINCE MARCH 9, 2009

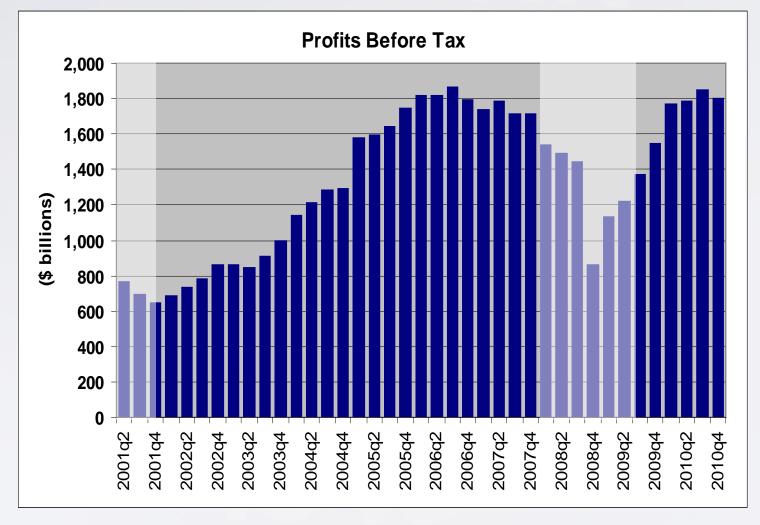








CORPORATIONS ARE DOING WELL PROFITS AT NEW LEVELS

MANAGING RISK WHERE IS THE INCENTIVE TO EXPAND



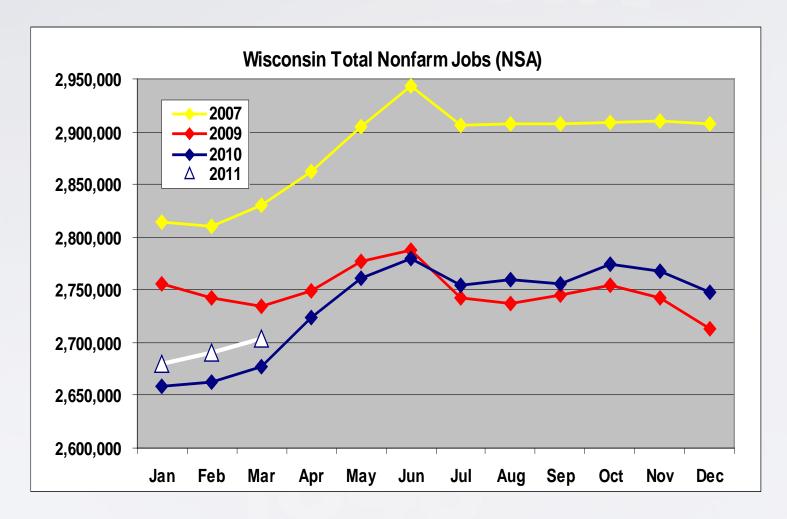

Job Losses in Recent Recessions - Wisconsin - # of Months Since Recession Declaration





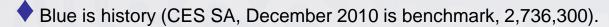

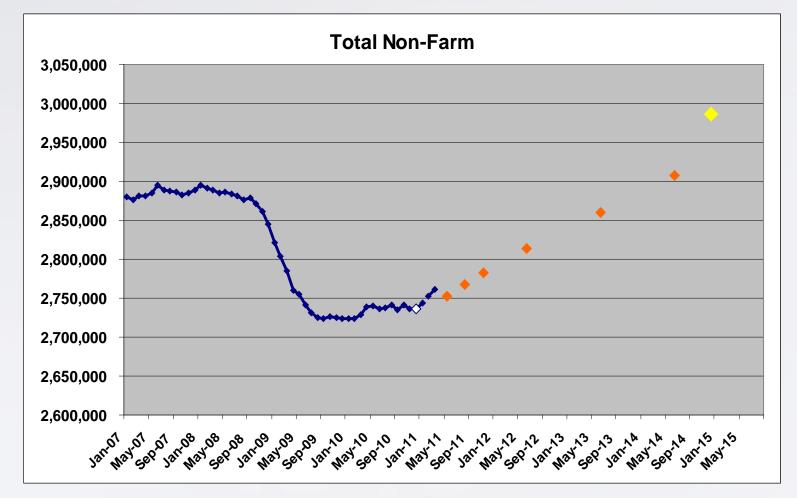

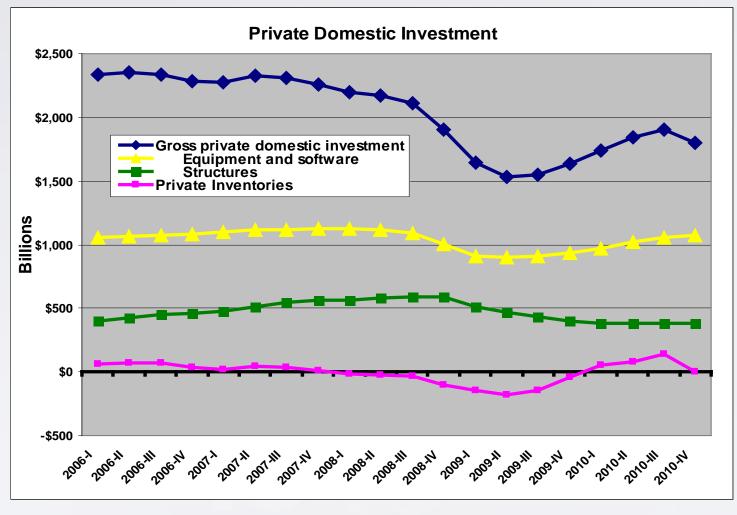

INVESTMENT GROWTH IS IN PRODUCTIVITY, NOT EXPANSION

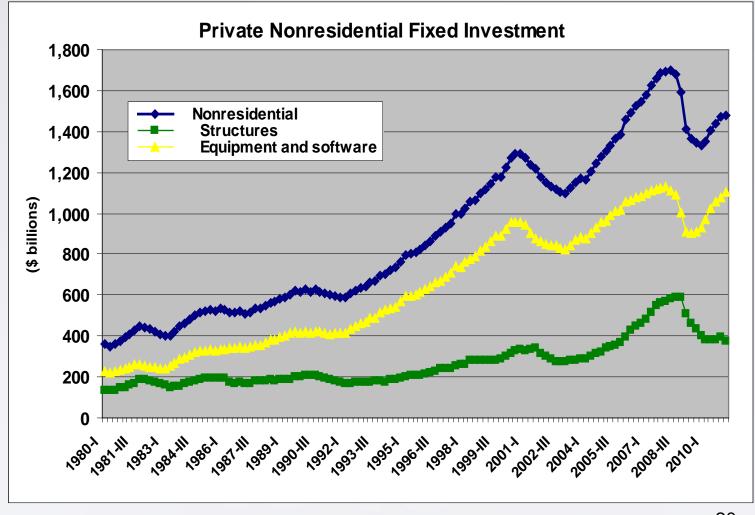

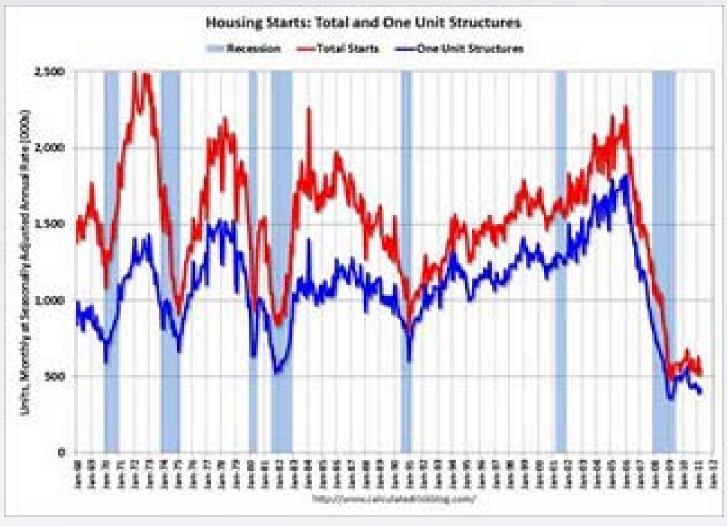








HOUSING TURNAROUND PENDING? STILL BARRIERS TO OVERCOME

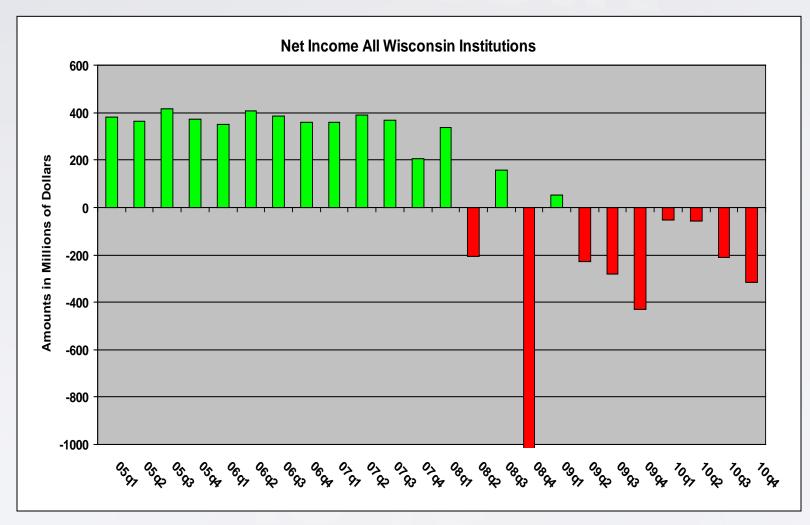








WISCONSIN BANKS STILL REPORTING LOSSES





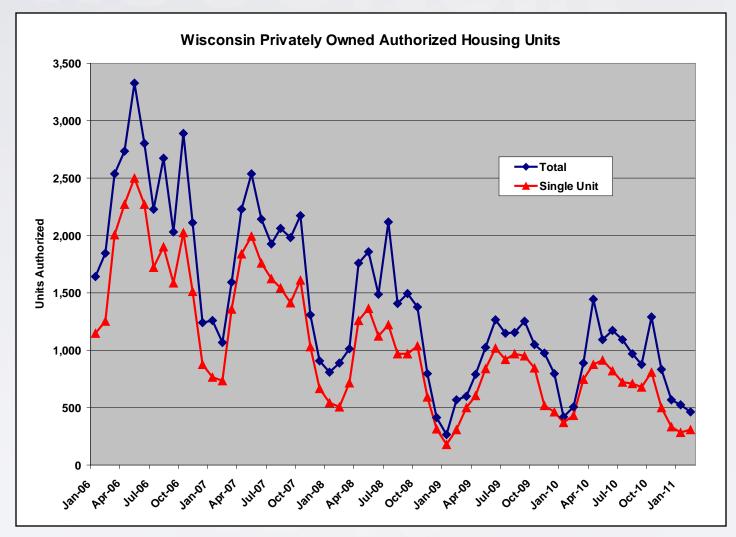








WISCONSIN HOUSING DOWN BOTTOMED?

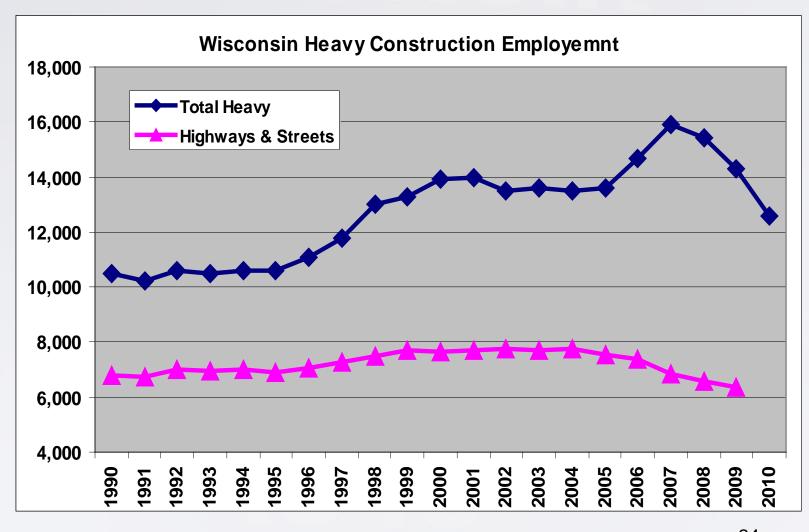

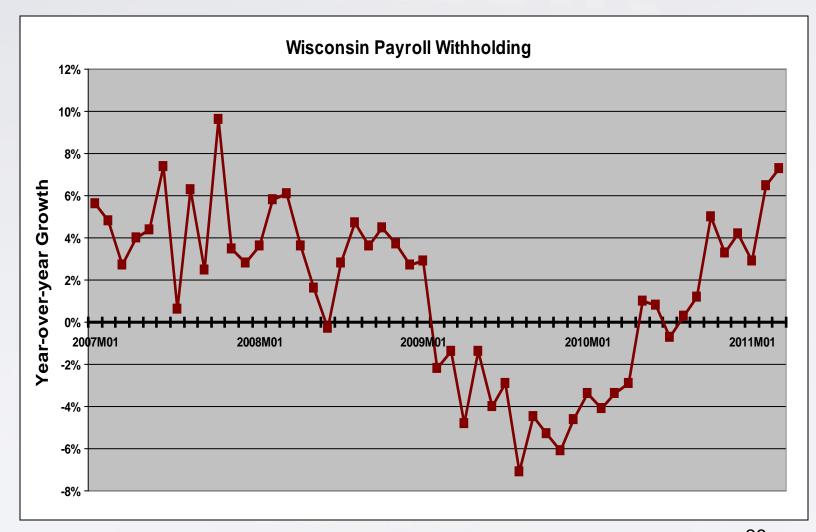






WISCONSIN WITHHOLDING COLLECTIONS UP

7.3% OVER THE YEAR



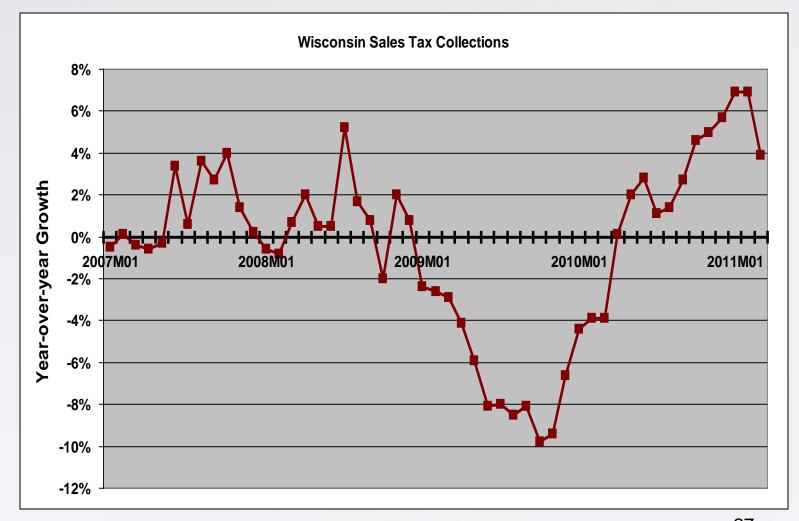








WISCONSIN SALES TAX COLLECTIONS UP 3.9% OVER THE YEAR

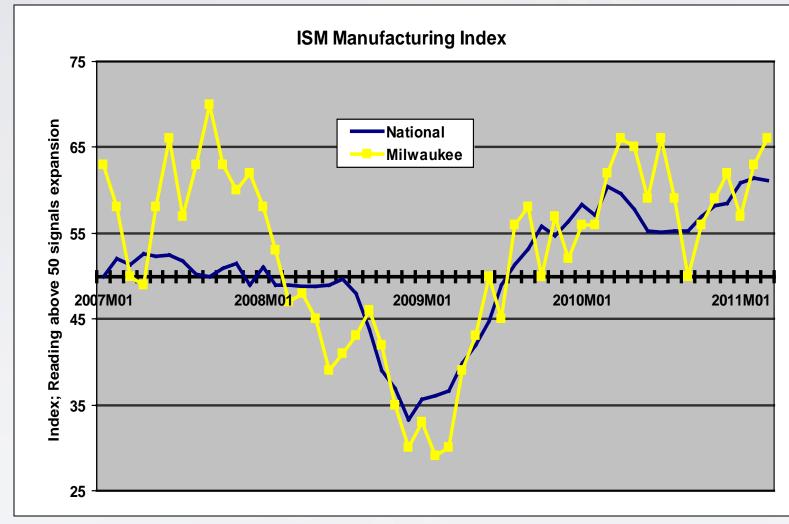








ISM MANUFACTURING INDEX MILWAUKEE AREA BANDS U.S.





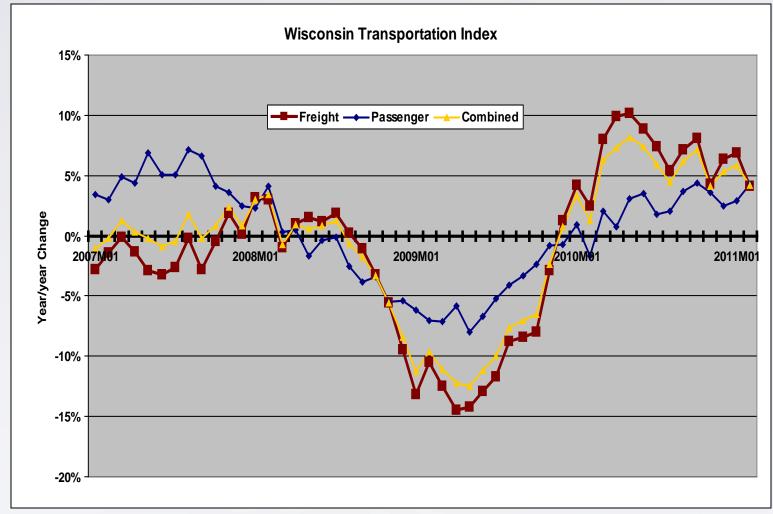






WISCONSIN TRANSPORTATION SERVICES INDEX

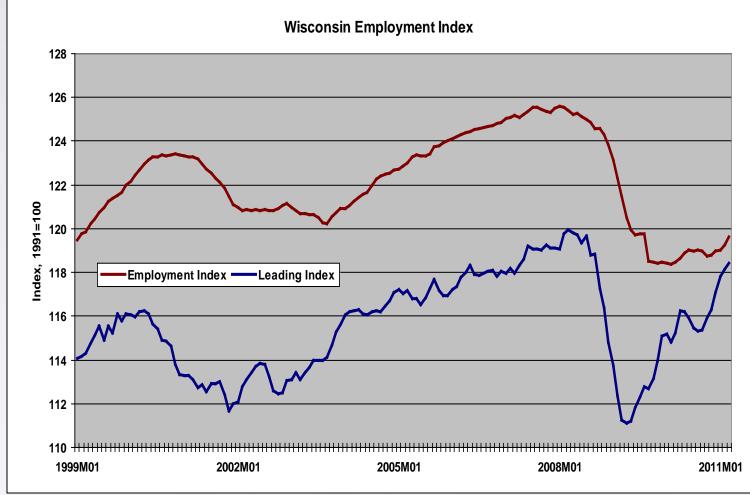






LEADING COMPONENT SHOWING PROMISE

WISCONSIN EMPLOYMENT INDEX



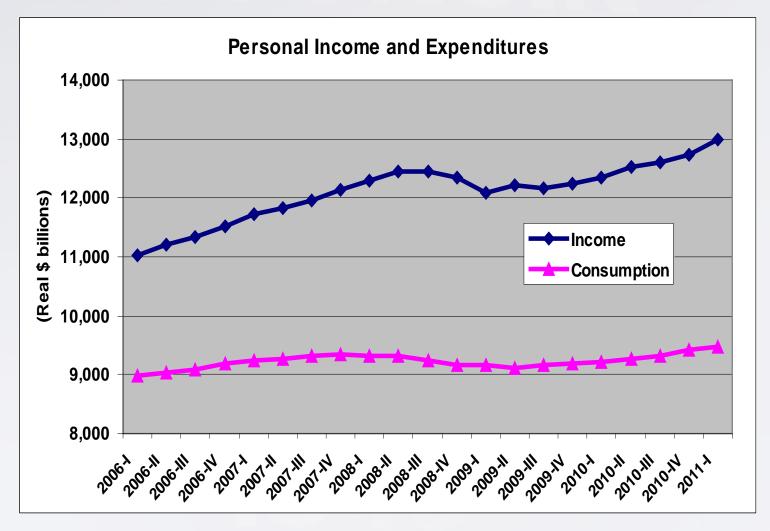








INCOME GAINS OUTPACING CONSUMPTION

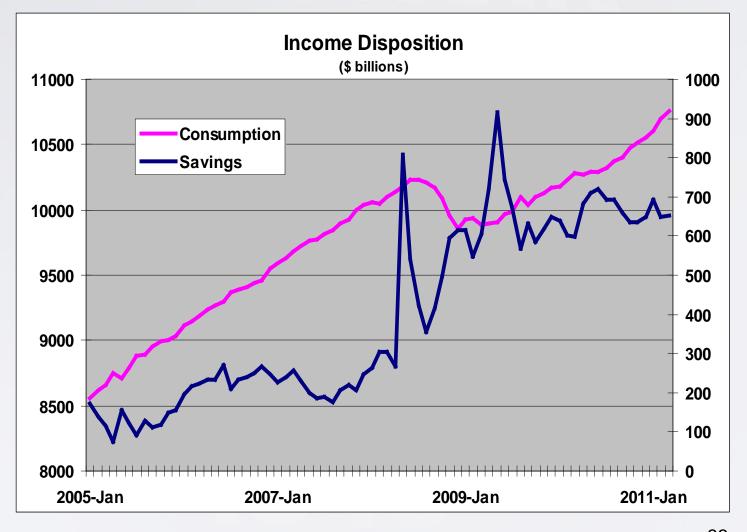








CONSUMPTION v. SAVINGS SHORT-RUN v. LONG-RUN
