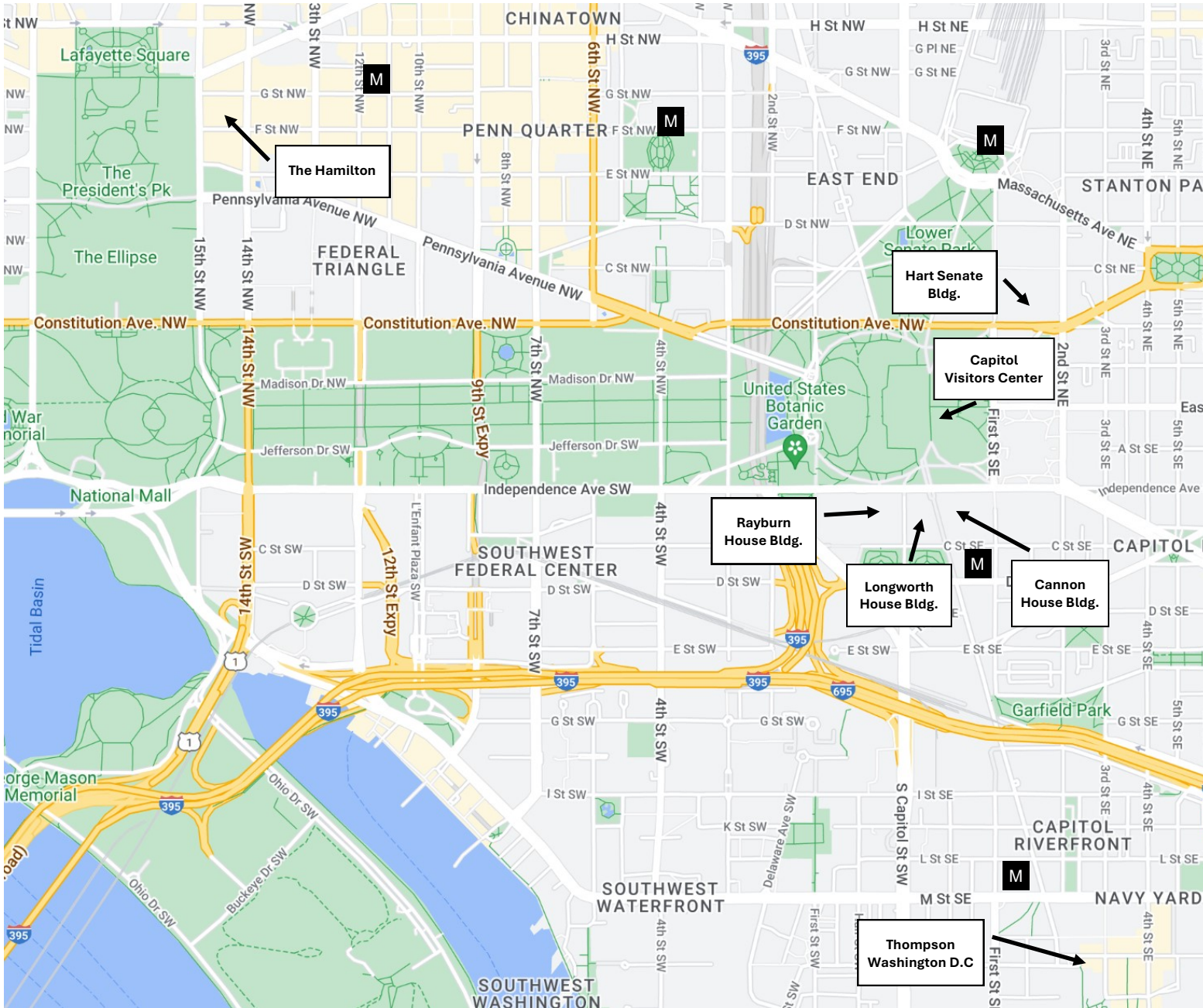


Map of the Capitol Hill Area

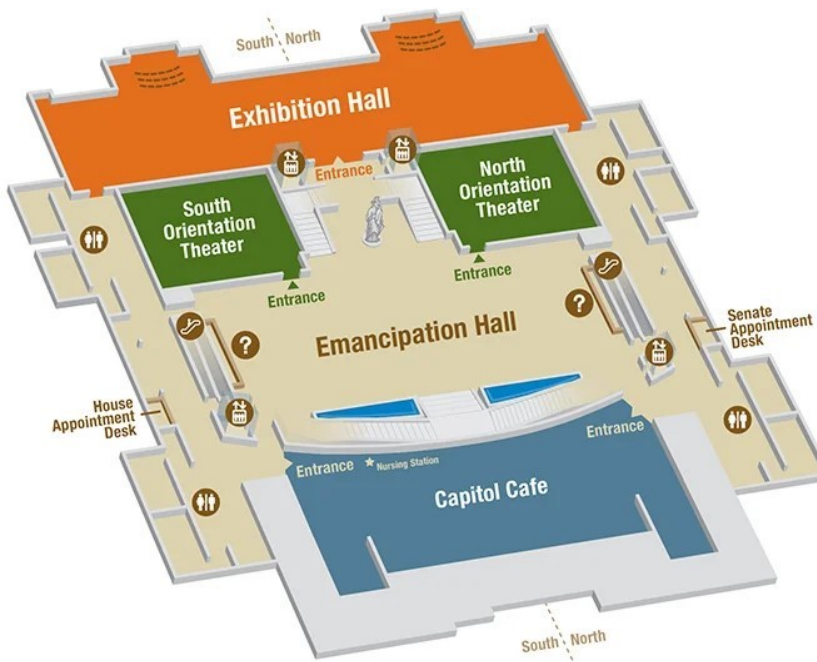

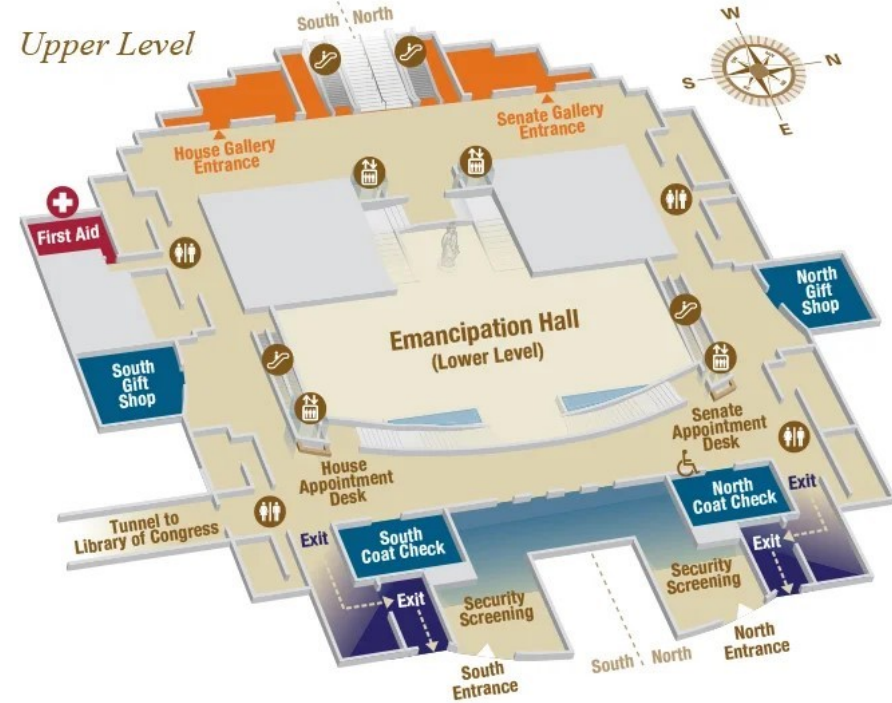
If you are interested in traveling the city by public transportation, consider downloading the DC Metro and Bus app. Available on the Apple App Store and on the Google Play Store.

Visitors may request wheelchairs at the North Coat Check, located to the right of the visitor entrance on the Upper Level, or from Capitol Visitor Center staff. All restrooms are accessible.

DIRECTIONS FROM CAPITOL VISITOR CENTER MAIN ENTRANCE – FIRST STREET:

Proceed through the secured entrance off First Street, NE. Once through security, use the escalator behind the upper-level Senate Appointment Desk to go down one level to Emancipation Hall and look for the lower-level Senate Appointment Desk. They will check you in. Please bring a form of photo identification.

Note: If there is a long line of tourists when you arrive at the Capitol Visitor Center, you may go to the front of the line and inform the police officer that you are there on “official business” to attend an event. **Depending on the day, mention the group name, event, and room listed below:**
